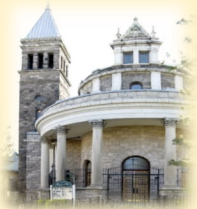

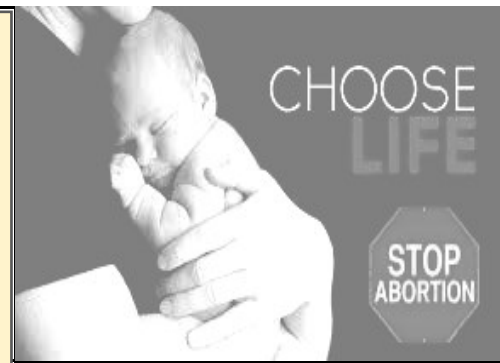

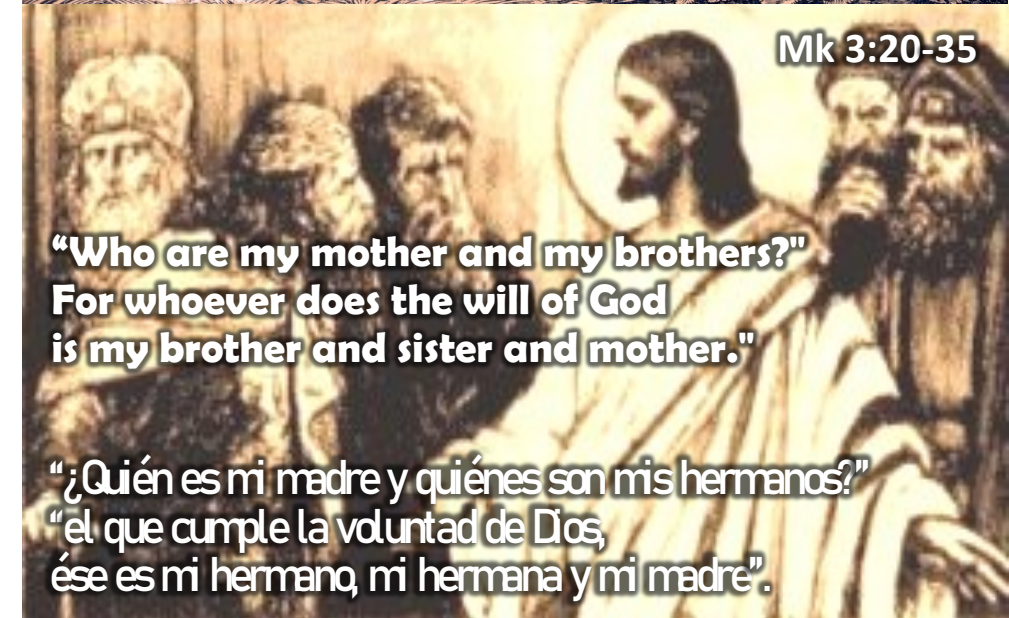

## POPE FRANCIS

**GENERAL AUDIENCE 05/29/20**  
*Summary of the Holy Father's words*

Dear brothers and sisters: In our ongoing catechesis on the Spirit and the Bride, we now centre our attention on the Biblical name of Holy Spirit, which in Hebrew is *Ruach*, meaning breath, wind, or spirit. This name highlights the Spirit's profound power and freedom. Jesus likens the Spirit to the wind that blows where it wills, thus emphasizing the freedom of the Holy Spirit, who not only creates and inspires but always remains free, bestowing his gifts "as he wills" (1 Cor 12:11). Saint Paul affirms this, stating: "Now the Lord is Spirit and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom" (2 Cor 3:17). This freedom is given to us as a gift so that we can do God's will, rather than merely following our personal desires. Where do we attain this freedom of the Spirit, so contrary to the spirit of selfishness? The answer is in the words that Jesus spoke to his followers: "If the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed" (Jn 8:36). Let us ask Jesus, through his Holy Spirit, to make us truly free. Free to serve with love and joy.

*Resumen leído por el Santo Padre en español*


*Queridos hermanos y hermanas:*

Seguimos reflexionando sobre el Espíritu Santo. En la Biblia se lo denomina "*Ruah*", que significa soplo, aliento, viento. La imagen del viento nos remite al poder de Dios, que tiene una fuerza imparable, capaz de transformarlo todo a su paso. Además de la fuerza del viento, el Evangelio pone en evidencia otra característica: la libertad. "El viento sopla donde quiere, no sabes de dónde viene ni adónde va", dice Jesús. Esto indica que el Espíritu Santo no se puede encerrar ni reducir en teorías o conceptos meramente humanos.

Por otra parte, san Pablo afirma que "donde está el Espíritu del Señor, allí está la libertad", es decir, que el Espíritu de Dios nos hace verdaderamente libres. Pero la libertad puede entenderse de diversas maneras, puede convertirse en un pretexto para hacer lo que cada uno quiere; por eso, el Apóstol aclara que la libertad cristiana consiste en adherir libremente a la voluntad de Dios. Y esto se expresa en el amor y en el servicio a los demás, tal como nos enseñó Jesús con su propia vida.
