

Catequesis. Vicios y virtudes

4. La lujuria

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, ¡buenos días!

En la catequesis de hoy, se habló sobre los vicios y las virtudes. Se mencionó que después de la gula, el siguiente vicio es la lujuria, que es una especie de "voracidad" hacia otra persona, especialmente en el ámbito de la sexualidad.

Entiéndase bien: en el cristianismo no se condena el instinto sexual. Un libro de la Biblia, el Cantar de los Cantares, es un maravilloso poema de amor entre una pareja de novios. Sin embargo, esta hermosa dimensión de nuestra humanidad, la dimensión sexual, la dimensión del amor, no está exenta de peligros, hasta el punto de que ya San Pablo tiene que abordar la cuestión en la primera Carta a los Corintios. Escribe así: "Es cosa pública que se cometen entre ustedes actos deshonestos, como no se encuentran ni siquiera entre los paganos" (5,1). El reproche del Apóstol se refiere precisamente a un uso-malsano de la sexualidad por parte de algunos cristianos

La lujuria puede devastar las relaciones entre las personas, convirtiéndolas en relaciones

tóxicas y carentes de respeto. La castidad, que no debe confundirse con la abstinencia sexual, es la virtud que nos permite amar al otro, respetarlo, buscar su felicidad y cultivar la empatía por sus sentimientos.

Entre todos los placeres del hombre, la sexualidad tiene una voz poderosa. Implica todos los sentidos; habita tanto en el cuerpo como en la psique, y esto es bellísimo, pero si no se disciplina con paciencia, si no se inscribe en una relación y una historia en la que dos personas la transforman en una danza amorosa, se convierte en una cadena que priva al hombre de libertad. El placer sexual, que es un don de Dios, se ve socavado por la pornografía: satisfacción sin relación que puede generar formas de adicción.

La lujuria nos lleva a buscar el placer sin importar el otro, a juzgar aburrido el cortejo y a buscar atajos. Debemos defender el amor, el amor puro de donarse recíprocamente y preservar la belleza que Dios escribió en su creación cuando imaginó el amor entre el hombre y la mujer.

Ganar la batalla contra la lujuria es un esfuerzo que dura toda la vida, pero el premio de esta batalla es el más importante de todos, ya que se trata de preservar la belleza del amor verdadero.

Catechesis. Vices and Virtues.

4. Lust

Dear brothers and sisters, good morning!

In today's catechism, we talked about vices and virtues. It was mentioned that after gluttony, the next vice is lust, which is a kind of "voracity" towards another person, especially in the area of sexuality.

Let it be understood well: in Christianity the sexual instinct is not condemned. A book of the Bible, the Song of Songs, is a wonderful love poem between an engaged couple. However, this beautiful dimension of our humanity, the sexual dimension, the dimension of love, is not free of dangers, to the point that Saint Paul already has to address the issue in the first Letter to the Corinthians. He writes thus: "It is a public thing that dishonest acts are committed among you, such as are not found even among pagans" (5,1). The Apostle's reproach refers precisely to an unhealthy use of sexuality by some Christians.

Lust can devastate relationships between people, turning them into toxic and disrespectful relationships. Chastity, which should not be confused with sexual abstinence, is the virtue that allows us to love others,



respect them, seek their happiness and cultivate empathy for their feelings. Among all the pleasures of man, sexuality has a

powerful voice. It involves all the senses; It lives in both the body and the psyche, and this is beautiful, but if it is not disciplined with patience, if it is not part of a relationship and a story in which two people transform it into a loving dance, it becomes a chain. that deprives man of freedom. Sexual pleasure, which is a gift from God, is undermined by pornography: satisfaction without relationship that can lead to forms of addiction.

On the other hand, lust leads us to seek pleasure regardless of the other, to judge courtship as boring and to look for shortcuts. We must defend love, the pure love of giving reciprocally and preserving the beauty that God wrote in his creation when he imagined the love between man and woman.


Winning the battle against lust is a lifelong endeavor, but the prize of this battle is the most important of all, as it is about preserving the beauty of true love.
